Epsom Coaches have enjoyed another successful summer, with more tour operators joining our satisfied clients. We have also been successful in gaining the contract to operate Australian Pacific's newly introduced UK tour programme. In a two year deal we have contracted to operate 8, 13 day round Britain tours in 1999 and 16 in 2000. A new 49 seat touring coach will be required and an order is shortly to be placed for delivery in good time for the first tour in May of next year.

comfortable service to our customers. This in addition to four new Mercedes buses due for the revised K9 and 10 services with, for the first time automatic gearboxes. A further Mercedes has been ordered for new London Transport route 404. The new Mercedes are expected in late October

"New LT Tender starts September

London Transport have awarded service 404 between Old Coulsdon and Caterham on the Hill to Epsom Buses. This route requires an additional mini-bus which will arrive in late October 1998. As the service is currently operated on a temporary contract by Metrobus, an existing Mercedes will be used from the start date in late September until the new bus arrives. The 404 tender is for 5 years and will be integrated with the current 463 duties. The 463 service itself will be subject to re-tender in January 99 having established itself on a one year trial basis. Epsom Buses now operate 5 London Transport tenders using 19 buses

K9 & 10 Campaign

Due to overwhelming public support the K9 & 10 has been saved and is now a Surrey County Council tendered route. Epsom Buses have been successful in winning the five year contract with changes to the route in the Borough of Kingston to aid reliabilty-

Transport White Paper After much delay the transport white paper has been published and promises to devote resources from the motorist to publictransport. How this will be introduced has still to be determined but road tolls and taxing employee car parking spaces has been suggested. One benefit will be the raising of the overall limit for coach weights from 17 to 18 tonnes leaving a little more margin for French beer!!!!
